Subject : Removal of Ban on Visa On Arrival for Australian Passport Holders

This is to inform you that the National Executive Council on 23 June 2016 approved the removal of the ban on visa on arrival for Australian Passport Holders.

Holders of Australian Passport Holders wishing to visit PNG for tourism purposes will now be able to obtain a Visitor visa upon arrival in PNG at the Jacksons International Airport, Gurney, Mount Hagen and Tokua Airports.

This tourist Visitor visa will be valid for 30 days only and cannot be extended. It will be visa fee free.

Applicants must have a passport valid for more than 6 months, return or onward ticket and show evidence of funds.

Over stayers of this facility will be placed on Alert and will not be eligible for visa on arrival.

This facility is effective as of the date of this Circular.
